# **EUROPEAN STONECHAT** (Saxicola rubicola)

#### **IDENTIFICATION**

13-15 cm. **Male** with black head and neck, brown in **female**; both sexes with white patch on neck and wing. **Juveniles** brown, similar to a **female** but paler.




### **SIMILAR SPECIES**

Male is unmistakable. Female recalls a Whinchat, with white supercilium, white patch on base of tail feathers and with spotted uppertail coverts.







#### **SEXING**

In adult birds, male with black upperparts (head, neck, mantle); patch on neck pure white; rump with white patch; 3 or 4 all white inner greater coverts; dark tail. Female is brownish and without white patch on rump; patch on neck is not pure white; 1 or 3 all white inner greater coverts; brownish tail. Juveniles can be sexed in extreme birds: male with less than 6 brown outermost grater coverts; innermost greater coverts pure white; breast tinged chestnut; tail and wing coverts dark. Female with more than 7 brown outermost grater coverts; innermost greater coverts creamy-white; pale breast; tail and wing coverts brownish.

#### **AGEING**

3 age groups can be recognized:

Juvenile with fresh plumage; head and upperparts speckled pale; inside of upper mandible yellowish till October.

1st year autumn/2nd year spring with contrast between moulted wing feathers, which are darker than pale brown juvenile retained (check moult limits within greater coverts, within tertials or between moulted tertials and inner secondaries).

Adult without moult limits on wing; dark colour inside of upper mandible.

CAUTION: the inner greater covert next to the white coverts has a darker pattern looking like a moult limit.






Stonechat. Pat-Ageing. tern of head: top female; bottom juvenile.

#### **MOULT**

Complete postbreeding moult, usually finished early October. Partial postjuvenile moult involving body feathers, lesser, median and some inner greater coverts; some birds extend their moult to all greater coverts, some or all tertials and some flight feathers; usually finished early October.

#### **STATUS IN ARAGON**


Resident, with contribution of wintering European birds. Widely distributed throughout the Region, absent only from the highest areas of the Pyrenees.




