

IDENTIFICATION OF MOUSTACHED WARBLER (*Acrocephalus melanopogon*), AQUATIC WARBLER (*Acrocephalus paludicola*) AND SEDGE WARBLER (*Acrocephalus schoenobaenus*)

ALL AGES

All ages can be separated by head and rump pattern and primary projection.



Moustached Warbler: whitish throat; pure white and wide supercilium; blackish lores; crown unstreaked blackish; unstreaked rump; short primary projection.



Aquatic Warbler: pale creamy throat; creamy supercilium; without dark lores; crown with a pale line in the centre; streaked rump; short primary projection.



Sedge Warbler: pale creamy throat; creamy supercilium; brownish lores; crown streaked dark; unstreaked rump; long primary projection.
